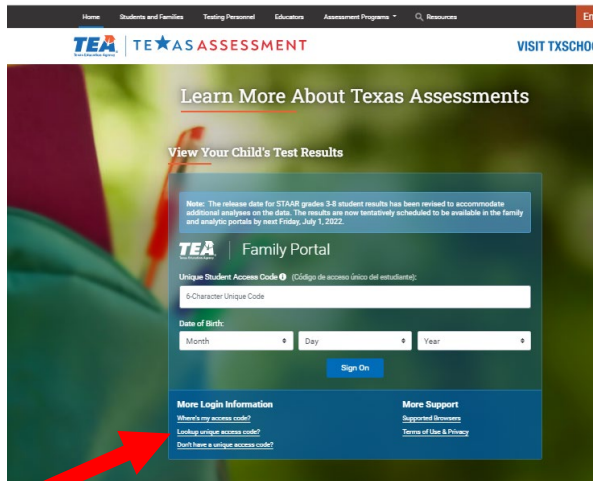


Accessing Your Student's STAAR Report Card

Follow the steps listed to access Student STAAR Scores via the Online Portal:

1. Enter the following URL into your web browser. This will take you to the login page:
<http://www.texasassessment.gov>
2. Enter the student unique access code (if you have it from previous years) and **date of birth** click on the tab "SIGN ON"



3. **If you do not know the student's unique access code**, you can find it by clicking on "Lookup Unique Access Code?" (see red arrow diagram above) and entering the following:
 1. The student's First Name
 2. The Social Security # **OR** TSDS #, (Don't use dashes on the SSN, and don't use the Tab key, or the website will delete the SSN. ***If you are using SSN, leave the TSDS field blank, and click to select the date of birth.
 3. The student's DATE OF BIRTH.

Once you have the Student Access Code, you may complete the instruction in STEP 2 by clicking the blue **GO** button to view your STAAR scores.

To log in and view your child's assessment results, enter the six-character Unique Access Code and the date of birth that appears on their most recent STAAR Report Card. The code must be entered exactly as it appears.

Don't Have a Unique Access Code?

If you don't have a Unique Access Code or a copy of your child's STAAR Report Card, please contact your local school.

4. The next screen will provide you with your students “Unique Student Access Code”, select the blue button once again, and your student’s STAAR report card will display.

HOW TO UNDERSTAND PERFORMANCE

Your child's scores include performance scores for each subject area. Here are the performance levels and what they mean:

 Meets Grade Level <small>Shows mastery of the course content → student is on track for college and career readiness.</small>	 Approaches Grade Level <small>Shows strong knowledge of course content → student is prepared to progress to the next grade.</small>	 Does Not Meet Grade Level <small>Shows some knowledge of course content but may be missing critical elements → student may need additional support in the coming year.</small>	 Did Not Meet Grade Level <small>Shows a lack of basic understanding of course content → student needs significant support in the coming year.</small>
