Since then there have been multiple inquiries to the district regarding the incident and some misinformation that may be spreading through the community. At this time we would like to clarify several aspects of the incident. These clarifications about the incident on December 13th are listed below:

- There was no mention or threat of a school shooting presented to the district.
- There were no weapons on campus.

We appreciate everyone's understanding in these matters. We wanted to ensure all stakeholders were aware of the misrepresentation of some of the facts of the situation.

The district would like all stakeholders to know that safety is a primary objective of the district. As always, if you have any concerns about school safety please inform either the Mount Enterprise ISD Chief of Police or a district administrator.
